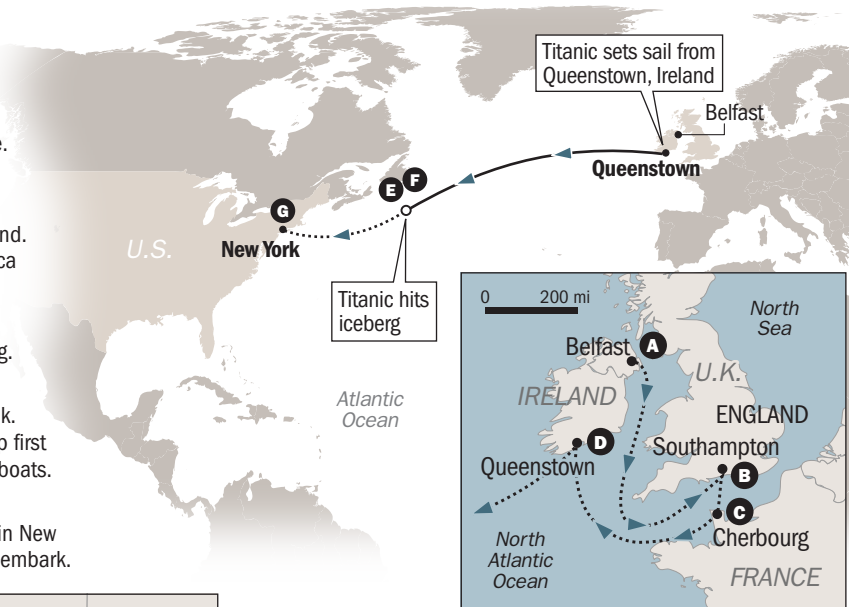


How Titanic's maiden voyage unfolded

- A April 2**
After completing sea trials, RMS Titanic sails from Belfast, Northern Ireland, to Southampton, England.
- B April 4**
Titanic arrives in Southampton.
- C April 10**
Titanic arrives in Cherbourg, France.
- D April 11**
Titanic arrives in Queenstown, Ireland. Departs for America the same day.
- E April 14**
Titanic hits iceberg.
- F April 15**
Ship begins to sink. Carpathia picks up first survivors from lifeboats.
- G April 18**
Carpathia arrives in New York. Survivors disembark.

RMS Titanic made stops in England, France and Ireland before departing on April 11, bound for New York City across the North Atlantic. Of 13 Finnish immigrants who boarded Titanic en route to Monessen or Coal Center in southwestern Pennsylvania, five would survive.
